# **COVID-19 Health and Safety**

Our staff team is diligently preparing to welcome your student(s) back to full-day inperson school next Wednesday, September 1<sup>st</sup>. We have developed school-wide COVID Safety Procedures and Mitigating Measures directly aligned with WA State Department of Health guidance for public schools. As always, student and staff physical safety and social-emotional well-being will be our highest priorities as we begin the 2021-22 school year. #### **School Lunches**

All students enrolled in the Bellevue School District can receive lunch at no charge during the 2021-2022 school year. Tillicum will also have access to a pilot breakfast program at the start of the year. Read more about the BSD Nutrition Services Programs.

Please know that student lunch times will comply fully with WA Department of Health recommendations for schools. Within lunches, we'll be implementing the following mitigating measures:

- Any student who chooses will be able to eat outside, either in our interior courtyard or behind the commons near the small playfield and basketball courts
- Students who choose to eat inside will all be spaced 6 feet apart from peers, eating on an individual chair that has been measured and placed to ensure physical distancing
- All students indoors will be expected to keep a face covering/mask on at all times when not actively eating or drinking

Why do we need to complete an application for school meal benefits if meals are offered free for all students? Completing the school meal benefit application to qualify for free or reduced priced meals will allow your student to gain access to:

- Fee Waivers or discounts offered by the district. The Fee Waiver Program offers waived fees for IB & AP tests, extracurricular activities such as ASB dues, event registrations, field trips, performances, social events/dances, transportation fees, athletic fees, and discounted summer school tuition.
- Community resources such as Operation School Bell, Backpack Meals and Shoes that Fit.
- Potential expansion of federal P-EBT benefits.
- Uninterrupted school meal benefits for the first 30 days of the 2022-2023 school year.

# **COVID-19 Vaccination Pop-Up Clinic**

We have appointments available for the Pfizer vaccine, the Moderna vaccine, and the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. Appointments are available to all BSD students aged 12 and up, their family members, employees and their families, and members of the community. To be eligible for the Pfizer vaccine, you must be aged 12 or older. To be eligible for the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines, you must be aged 18 or older. We are also offering the flu shot!

If you have access to a printer, please complete and print the Informed Consent and Release of Information form (link is available after you sign up for an appointment through the link above) and bring it with you to the clinic. We will also have copies of the form available for you to complete at the clinic. \*\*\*Parent/guardian signature on this document is required if the person being vaccinated is under age 18.

Parent/guardian must accompany all people receiving the vaccine who are 12-15 years old.

At check-in, please bring with you and have your health insurance card ready. If you do not have health insurance, you will not be turned away.
